

## Making a Wreath of Artificial Flowers



### You Will Need

- 20 gauge florist wire
  - Floral tape
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- Wire cutter
  - 4 buttonhole loops
  - Hot glue gun
  - Silk floral branches with leaves
  - Dried baby's breath
  - 8yd. satin ribbon, 1/4in. wide
1. Form a base as in steps 1 and 2 for making a wreath of fresh flowers.
  2. Cut blossoms off floral branches, leaving 1in. or more stem. Cut leaf clusters into individual leaves, with no stem. Attach one leaf to each blossom stem by putting a dot of glue at base of leaf and wrapping base around stem .Wrap stem and leaf base with floral tape. Prepare about 15 blossoms.
  3. Cut small pieces of baby's breath, group together to form clusters, and wrap stems together with floral tape for 1in. Prepare about 30 clusters.
  4. Cut about twenty 4in. lengths of ribbon. Bring ends together, wrap with floral tape for 1in., forming loop.

**Delight** is a satin ribbon edge veil. The satin ribbon used in this veil is white with silver edging. This is a cascading veil, and is available in fingertip and three quarter length.

**Desire** is a beaded edge veil. This is a square cut veil, with a hand beaded edge and finished with teardrop crystals at each corner. This veil is available in fingertip length only.

**Diana** is a plain or cut edge veil. This is a square cut veil, with teardrop crystals sewn to each corner. This veil is available in fingertip length only.

**Elegance** is a satin binding edge (or satin bound edge) veil. It is a two tier veil, available in waist and fingertip length, three quarter length, chapel and cathedral length.



### Wedding Veil Styles

**Allure** is a plain or cut edge veil, available in several styles. As a single tier veil, it is available in waist and fingertip lengths. As a two tier veil, it is available in waist and fingertip length, three quarter length, chapel and cathedral length.

**Allure Sparkle** is the same as Allure, with the difference of scattered crystals all over. This is a single tier veil, available in waist and fingertip lengths. It is also available as a two tier veil as a custom order.

**Amelia** is a plain or cut edge veil. This is a square cut veil, with teardrop pearls sewn to each corner. This veil is available in fingertip length only.

**Beauty** is a filigree or ruffled edge veil. This veil is a two tier veil with extra fullness, and is available in waist and fingertip length, three quarter length, chapel and cathedral length.

**Crystal** is a crystal beaded edge veil. This is a square cut veil, with a hand beaded edge using Swarovski crystals (AB) and finished with teardrop crystals (AB) at each corner. This veil is available in fingertip length only.

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**Enchanted** is a plain or cut edge veil. This is a square cut veil, with a diamante design at each corner, finished with teardrop crystals. It is available in silver diamantes and clear crystals, or AB diamantes and AB crystals. This veil is available in fingertip length only.

**Gloria** is a pencil edge veil, with Swarovski crystals hand sewn around the edge in a scattered pattern. This is a cascading veil, and is available in fingertip length only. Other lengths are available as a custom order.

**Grace** is a satin cord edge veil. This is a cascading veil, and is available in fingertip and three quarter length.

**Grace Sparkle** is the same as Grace, with the difference of scattered crystals all over. This is a cascading veil, and is available in fingertip and three quarter length.



5. Tape flowers to base as in step 5 for making a wreath with fresh flowers. Alternate baby's breath, blossom, baby's breath, ribbon loop.
6. Cut and attach streamers. Fold 1 1/2yd. of ribbon into 10 loops, and secure middle of loops with wire; glue loops to base, over streamers. Cut blossoms just below base; glue over center of loops, hiding wire. Or in place of streamers and bow, hot glue veil to inside of center back.

## Making a Cloud of Roses Wreath

### You Will Need

- 20 gauge florist wire; wire cutter
- Floral tape
- 1/2 yd. illusion, 72in. wide
- 1/8yd. polyfleece
- 4 buttonhole loops
- 2yd. ribbon rose garland
- 2yd. satin ribbon, 1/16in. wide
- 2yd. satin ribbon 1/8in. wide

**Joy** is a satin ribbon edge veil. This is a three tier veil with extra fullness, and is available in fingertip and three quarter length.

**Princess** is a satin binding edge (or satin bound edge) veil. This is a cascading veil, and is available in fingertip and three quarter length.

**Romance** is a satin cord edge veil, available in several styles. As a single tier veil, it is available in waist and fingertip lengths. As a two tier veil, it is available in waist length, fingertip length, three quarter length, chapel and cathedral length.

**Victoria** is a pencil edge veil. This is a cascading veil, and is available in fingertip and three quarter length.

**Victoria Silver** is the same as Victoria, but with a silver metallic thread. This is a cascading veil, and is available in fingertip and three quarter length.

- Hot glue gun
1. Form base as in making a wreath with fresh flowers. Cut 2in. strips of polyfleece, and wrap around circle, gluing in place. Unfold net; scrunch up short width, and wrap around base, overlapping widths. Glue in place.
  2. Glue ribbons of rose garland to outside of wreath in a zigzag pattern, starting and ending at center back, apply glue under rosebuds, and allow connecting ribbon to form gentle loops.
  3. Cut two 1to 2in. streamers of ribbon rose garland, six 14in streamers of 1/16in ribbon. And two 14in. streamers of 1/8in ribbon. Tie knots every few inches in streamers without rosebuds. Glue tops of streamers to wreath at center back.
  4. Glue cluster of remaining buds over top of streamers. Glue button loops to inside of wreath; attach bobby pins.
